This program provides Public Schools, Public & Private Libraries and Rural Health Care institutions discounted telecommunications services, Internet access, and internal connections. The program reimburses up to 60% through the U.S. government's USAC division.



Few carriers have taken the time and effort to qualify for this program. These public and private institutions are interested in acquiring our services at discounted rates while receiving the additional government reimbursement. This is a HUGE selling point for these prospects, especially when they typically are operating with a limited budget.

**The Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) is a private, not for profit corporation that is responsible for providing every state and territory in the United States with access to affordable telecommunications services through the Universal Service Fund. All of the country's communities - including remote communities - such as rural areas, low-income neighborhoods, rural health care providers, public and private schools and public libraries, are eligible to seek support from the Universal Service Fund. USAC administers four support mechanisms: High Cost, Low Income, Rural Health Care, and Schools & Libraries. Each of these support mechanisms provides affordable access to modern telecommunications services for consumers, rural health care facilities, schools and libraries regardless of geographic location or socioeconomic status. High Cost and Low Income support mechanisms are managed by the High Cost and Low Income Division (HCLID); Rural Health Care support mechanism is managed by the Rural Health Care Division (RHCD); and Schools and Libraries support mechanism is managed by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD).*
